Study Questions

1). Why would repentance for Israel have been possible at the Lord's first advent through to 70AD even though the Jews were present in the land of Israel at the time?

2). Read John 6:14-15 – What are 'those men' talking about when they say that Jesus is 'truly the Prophet who is come into the world'?

a). Why does Jesus depart again to the mountain by Himself alone and why must He do this?

b). Where do we find a similar situation in the encounter between the Lord and Satan in the wilderness?

c). What is common to both these situations?

d). Read 2 Timothy 4:3 – what connection might there be between this verse concerning Christians and what we have just been studying?

e). What do you think all of this teaches us about our race of the faith on the one hand and understanding world events on the other?

3). Read John 6:15-17 – what do we see pictured in verses 16-17?

a). Within the chronology of scriptural events as we know them what must take place between verses 15 and 16 and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

b). So, why isn't this time between v16-17 seen here in John's Gospel and where else do we find this same time also omitted?

c). Where in Matthew did we find the events pictured through John 6:16-17 and what future events is Matthew describing?

d). What other scriptures did we look at in connection with this and what should we learn about Israel from them?

4). Read Jonah Chapter 1 – What do we learn from these verses?

a). Where in these verses from Jonah do we find that pictured through the disciples getting into the boat?

b). What is the difference between the great wind seen in Jonah and the great wind seen in John Chapter 6?

c). Read Revelation 7:1-4 – thinking about timing, how might these verses help us with understanding the great wind seen in John Chapter 6?
