Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 24:21-22 – What time is being prophetically described in these verses and what might we know about this time from them?

a). Where in the Book of the Revelation do we get a glimpse into the heavens that gives us information about some of those who are killed during the time pictured in Matthew 24:21-22 and what do we see?

b). What is the answer to their question, ‘How long....?’ And why must it be this way?

2). What takes place as each of the first 4 seals on the 7 sealed scroll are opened and what does this information provide for us?

a). Where does that pictured by the rider on the white horse find its origins in Jewish history?

b). How are Israel's actions described in Isaiah 28:15 and where does this find its ultimate fulfillment and which scripture did we look at that makes this very clear?

c). What do we see pictured through the ride of the rider on the pale horse and how have circumstances on the earth gotten to this state?

d). Read Matthew 24:7-9 – Where in these verses do we find the division between the first half and the second half of the Tribulation?

e). What is clearly shown to be happening during the first half of the Tribulation which can only get worse during the second?

f). Through the ride of which horse is this specifically seen in the Revelation?

g). Why will famine become a real issue, especially for the Jewish people during the second half of the Tribulation and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

h). How does all of this help our understanding of what we call the 'sheep and goats' judgment?

i). Where is this famine first seen in foundation?

j). Which verses did we read that describe a famine in the days of Elijah and Elisha?

k). Read Ezekiel 5:5-13 – What do we learn from these verses?

l). Read John 11:35 – Why does this happen?

m). Before the famine for 7 years seen in Genesis Chapter 41 there were 7 years of plenty – can we find any application for ourselves in this and are there any scriptures you can find that would show us how to act during a time of plenty?
