Study Questions

1). How stark will the contrast be between the years of the Tribulation and the years of the Millennial Kingdom and what, from the scriptures, would make you think so?

a). Read Acts 3:20-21 – What does this verse teach us about the extent of the changes that will occur during the Kingdom Age and what will these changes look like?

b). How certain are you that the events we have been studying will actually take place?

c). Read Jude 1:3-5 – If Jude’s original audience, as with us, would have the certainty of what was going to happen in the future from the scriptures, why do you think that the Holy Spirit sees fit to write what He does in these verses?

d). What does all of this, what we know of the future and Jude's words, say to you personally?

2). Read John 12:1 + 12-18 – These events take place immediately following the raising of Lazarus – Just from a numerical perspective where does the transition between v1 and v12 place us and what is in view?

a). Where in the OT scriptures do we find the original use of the phrase, “blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord” and what is the context for its use?

b). What exactly then are the people declaring by what they cry out as they go to meet Jesus entering Jerusalem?

c). In what way does this foreshadow what will take place at the end of the Tribulation?

d). What is the significance of the people carrying palm branches on the day the Lord enters Jerusalem and how can we trace this significance through the OT and NT scriptures?

e). Read Zechariah 9:9 – How does this verse connect with what we read in John 12:14-15 and what other connection did we make?

f). What do we know of Solomon and his kingdom?

g). What do we learn from John 12:16?

h). What do all these events, the previous 6 signs culminating in the raising of Lazarus and what follows, potentially set the stage for?

i). What is the reaction of the Jewish religious leaders and which verses did we look at in connection with this?

3). Read John 11:49-52 – What do we learn from these verses and where did we see this in foundation?

a). With national repentance rejected what are the only 2 things that now remain in view and which scriptures did we look at that show this?

b). From the scriptures how do we know that the Lord's resurrection is a sign?

c). If the Lord did not rise from the dead what would this mean for us and which scriptures did we look at to see this?
