Study Questions

1). Read Exodus 4:1-9 – What do you learn from these verses and what might they teach us about the ministry of the One greater than Moses?

a). What parallels can we find between Moses past ministry to the nation of Israel and the Lord's future ministry to the nation?

2). Read Judges 2:18-19 – What is the pattern that we see set in these verses?

a). What would be the importance of this pattern with respect to the Lord's first advent?

b). Which verses from Acts did we look at that again confirm this pattern?

c). How and when will this pattern be finally brought to a conclusion?

3). Read Genesis 1:1-5 and John 1:1-5 – Do both sets of verses deal with exactly the same thing?

a). What do we know about God from Genesis 1:1 and what further detail is given to us from John 1:1?

b). Read John 1:14 – What does this verse tell us about the Word?
[Perhaps a little more than the obvious]

c). How should we understand the statement ‘the Word was God’ and which scriptures did we look at that validate this?

d). What does this statement make clear about God the Father and God the Son and can you think of any scripture that would support this?

e). Read Malachi 3:6 – What does this mean for the way we are to view the Word of God?

f). What does this clearly teach about what God says and does and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

g). What does this unequivocally teach us about signs and wonders in the Church today and which scripture did we look at?

h). Read Proverbs 7:2 – What does this verse and all we have been studying say to you personally about the scriptures and how you are to relate to them?

4). Read John 1:3 – How does this verse conform to God’s creative process in Genesis Chapter 1 and how does it go beyond that seen in Genesis 1? Which scriptures did we look at?

a). All that we have looked at today concerning the Word is the same person who died and shed His blood for us. What do you think about that and how should we live because of it?
