Study Questions

1). What unique circumstance was in place immediately following the Lord's death and resurrection and why was this possible?

a). Why is the same circumstance not possible today and how would we know from the scriptures?

2). Read Romans 1:16 – Explain what we are told in this verse.

a). What should we know about the re-offer of the Kingdom to Israel by the Church and how does the verse from Romans help in our understanding?

3). Read Genesis 1:1-2 – What do we see in these verses and which scriptures did we look at that confirm this?

a). Given what we have just looked at what would be the significance of John's Gospel beginning in the same place?

b). In what way is that presented at the beginning of John's Gospel different from that seen in Genesis and what do they both have in common?

c). Who does John introduce at the beginning of his Gospel and which scriptures did we look at in connection with Him?

4). Read John 1:5 – Which day does this correspond to in Genesis?

a). Read John 1:29-34 – What is significant about the way these verses begin and what do we learn from them?

b). Read John 1:35-42 – What is significant about the way these verses begin and what do we learn from them?

c). Can you make any connection between what we see in these verses from John and what we see from day 3 of the restoration in Genesis?

d). Read John 1:43-51 – What is significant about the way these verses begin and what do we learn from them?

e). Read John 2:1-2 – What is significant about the way these verses begin, what is the double whammy we get from them and which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

f). What is the wedding in Cana of Galilee all about?

f). What do you think might be important about this being the beginning of signs?

g). Why does God structure the beginning of John to correspond with the beginning of Genesis?

h). So, which 2 ‘wedding festivities’ do we see at the end of the 6th day, when do they happen and what is so incredibly important about the fact that we see them taking place?
