Part Seven
Study Questions

1). Read John 2:6-10 – What is being pictured through these verses?

a). Which verses from Ezekiel describe this same process?

b). How does the wine produced from the water at the wedding in Cana connect with the foundation in Genesis and the events of the last supper in Matthew 26:27-30?

2). Read John 2:7 – The primary application for the water turned to wine concerns the restoration of Israel, but there is a secondary application which we can see for ourselves – Which verses did we look at from Ephesians that connect with John 2:7?

a). What is the companion verse from Colossians to go with the verses in Ephesians and what do we learn from it?

b). Read Romans 12:2 and 2 Corinthians 4:16 – how do these verses fit with the verses from Ephesians, Colossians and John?

c). What part did the stone waterpots at the wedding in Cana play in turning the water to wine?

d). So, how did it happen?

e). Where do we see the foundational pattern set for this?

f). What we see in Genesis forms a first mention principle – what does this tell us about the restoration of any subsequently ruined creation?

3). Read 1 John 1:1-5 – What do we see and what do we learn from these opening 5 verses in 1 John?

a). Compare 1 John 1:5 with John 1:1 – What do we learn from this?

b). What does John 1:4 tell us about the light and what does this mean?

c). So, to bring all of the parts of this question together, what does it mean to be continually filled with the Spirit?

4). Read Matthew 6:22-23 – What do we learn from these verses?

a). Read Proverbs 7:2 – Given what we learned in the study ‘The Eyes Have It’ how are we to understand our eye being ‘good’?

b). What would it mean then if our eye was ‘bad’?

c). Read Proverbs 7:3-4 and 1 Corinthians 1:22 – How do these verses connect?

d). What do we know about the word translated ‘seek’ in 1 Corinthians 1:22 and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

5). Read Matthew 5:13-16 – What parallels can we see here with the parable of the wise and foolish virgins?

a). What is the only way it would be possible for us to be salt and light and what would it mean for us to be these?

b). Which scripture did we look at in connection with this?
