Study Questions

1). Read Hosea 5:13-6:2 – How does what we read in these verses connect with what Jesus tells Nicodemus in John 3:3?

a). Putting these scriptures together, what is the only way in which Israel can be healed of her spiritual sickness?

b). What has caused this spiritual sickness and what is at the heart of it being there?

c). Read Revelation 3:14-17 – Do you see a parallel here with Israel during the time of Christ’s conversation with Nicodemus?

d). What is at the heart of the ‘spiritual sickness’ we see in Revelation Chapter 3 and what is the only solution to it?

e). Read 1 John 1:9 – What is the only way the sins of the saved can be dealt with?

2). Read 1 Peter 1:3-9 – How is the purpose for our eternal salvation set out in these verses?

a). What is our 'hope' as seen in Titus Chapter 2?

b). Which scripture did we look at that describes how we have come to know about our hope, our inheritance and the salvation of our soul?

c). What 2 interrelated actions bring this about and what are we commanded in Ephesians with respect to this?

3). Read Romans 12:2 – Explain the 2 commands given to us in this verse.

a). According to Romans 12:2 how is the metamorphosis accomplished?

b). Read 2 Corinthians 4:16 – What additional information are we given here concerning how the metamorphosis is accomplished?

c). Read Colossians 3:10 – What additional information are we given here concerning how the metamorphosis is accomplished?

d). What is the only way we can attain this ‘mature’ knowledge?

e). Read James 1:21-22 – What do these verses teach us about the metamorphosis and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

4). Read 2 Corinthians 4:6-7 – What is the treasure we have and why do we have it in earthen vessels?

a). Which other scripture did we look at that confirms what we see at the end of 2 Corinthians 4:7?

b). Read 1 John 2:29 and 1 John 4:7 – How should we understand what we see in these verses and which other examples did we look at?

c). Read 1 John 5:18 – How is this possible?
