Study Questions

- 1). Read Matthew 24:15-16 – What takes place at the mid-point in the Tribulation and which scriptures did we look at in connection with these things?
  
- 2). What happens immediately prior to this mid-point and which scriptures did we look at?
  
- 3). What happens immediately after the mid-point and which scriptures did we look at?
  - a). Given what we see in Luke 21:24 – how can we know for sure that these events have not happened in Israel’s past as so many people think?
  
- 4). Read Isaiah 66:7-9 again – what 2 periods of time are seen in these verses?
  - a). Who is the ‘male child’ in v7 and how would we know?

b). Following the 'birth' metaphor in these verses, who is to be born at once?

c). When exactly does this second 'birth' take place? And what event on Israel's prophetic calendar must be seen in conjunction with this?

5). Read Revelation 6:3-4 – Where in time do these verses bring us to?

a). What connection is there between the ride made by the fiery red horse and the ride made by the white horse that preceded it?

b). Who is the rider on the fiery red horse and what does Daniel Chapter 11:36-39 have to say about him?

c). What do we learn about him in these verses?

d). What is set in motion as the rider on the fiery red horse begins his ride and how did the Lord describe this time?

6). Read Deuteronomy 28:47-51 + 64-68 – What connection is there between these verses and the ride of the fiery red horse?

a). How do these verses from Deuteronomy connect with Isaiah 66:8-9?

b). And what connection is there between all of these verses and Matthew 24:7-9?

c). Within the context of our study, what is the purpose for the birth pangs experienced by Israel?

d). Where do we see this from our verses in Isaiah 66?

e). Which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

7). Which 2 promises found in the foundation must also be seen in conjunction with Israel's birth pangs?

a). Read Joel 3:2 – What is being described in this verse?

b). How does the end of this verse connect with the end of Daniel 11:39 and what would this mean for the Gentile nations under Antichrist?

8). Where do we find the complete picture of God's judgment on both Israel and the Gentile nations given to us in an overview?

a). How must we understand the relationship between the first 4 seals on the 7 sealed scroll?

b). Read each of the verses that describe the opening of the first 4 seals in order and give an explanation of what is seen as each seal is opened.

c). What is the connection between that seen through the opening of these seals and Isaiah 66:8-9, Matthew 24:8 and Mark 13:8?

9). Read Matthew 24:8-14 – What do we find in v8?

a). What do we see in v9-12?

b). What do we see in v13?

c). What then follows in v14?

d). What connection is there then between v14 and the verses that precede it?

e). Where did we see this same thing recorded in Mark's gospel?

f). What then could we say are the 2 major events taking place through the years of the Great Tribulation?

10). Read Revelation 14:1-10 – What do we see in v1-5?

a). What is taking place in v6?

b). What do we know about angels, men and the gospel?

c). Consequently, what must be the connection between that seen in v6 and the 5 verses that come before it?

d). What is it that the angel says in v7 and what is it definitely not?

e). What is then described in v8-10?

f). How do v8-10 connect with Isaiah 66, Matthew 24 and Mark 13?

g). What then is 'the everlasting gospel', who will be preaching it and when will they be doing it?

11). Read Revelation 6:9-11 – What do we know about the opening of the 5<sup>th</sup> seal?

a). Who are seen in these verses and what is said about them?

b). What is significant about the souls being seen under the altar?

c). Putting all this together then, what do we know about those seen in these verses?
