Study Questions

1). What is to take place that will precipitate Christ's return to the earth and which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

2). Read Exodus 4:22-23 and Exodus 12:26-29 – Which of the 7 feasts given to Israel do we see in these verses and what is the inextricable connected with this feast?

a). What declaration is made in Exodus 4:22-23 and what must be the outcome for that said here both past and future?

b). From the vantage point of history what do we know of Israel's behavior and therefore the purpose for God giving them the 7 feasts and which scriptures did we look at?

c). What is the basic sequencing that we see in both Exodus and Joshua with regards to the Passover and the destruction of Gentile world power?

d). What 2 additional things do we learn from these types in Exodus and Joshua and what do these mean with respect to the fulfillment of prophecy in the future?

e). Which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

f). What do we know about the fulfillment of the 7 feasts given to Israel with respect to the timeframe in which we find them?

3). Read Malachi 4:5-6 – What is to be the purpose for Elijah’s ministry in the time following the Lord’s return to the earth?

a). What connection would we see here with the ministry of John the Baptist?

b). Read Zechariah 12:10 and Amos 8:9 – What do we see in these 2 verses?

c). Read Romans 11:25 – What does this tell us about Israel’s present condition?

d). Can you find a type for this in the life of Paul?

e). How is Israel’s ‘blindness’ to be dealt with in that future day and which scripture did we look at with regards to this?

f). Which antitype did we look at that can be fulfilled at this time?

g). Read Isaiah 66:8 and John 1:29 – What is the connection between these 2 verses and why is this connection particularly significant?

4). Which of the 7 feasts comes in conjunction with and following the Passover and what does this feast have to do with?

a). Where in the OT scriptures do we find detail for the confession of this sin?

b). Read Numbers 19:11-13 – What significance do these verses have for Israel?

c). Read Numbers 35:9-16 + 30-33 – What does Numbers Chapter 35 teach us about the cities of refuge and their purpose?

d). Read Genesis 9:6 and Exodus 21:12 – What injunction does God set in place in these verses?

e). What should our attitude to these 2 verses be today?

f). Given what we see in Genesis and Exodus with regards to blood for blood, why do you think God introduces the cities of refuge in Numbers Chapter 35?

g). Blood for blood and the manslayer in the city of refuge – do these have to do with the eternally saved or the unsaved?

h). Read Exodus 12:6 – What does this verse tell us about the Lord's crucifixion?

i). How does all of this connect with what we read in Numbers Chapter 19?

j). What would it mean if Israel is guilty of premeditated murder?

k). What evidence do we find in the scriptures with regards to this and what does this show us?

l). Going back to that which we see in Numbers Chapter 35 for a moment, what do we know concerning a 'ransom' and the death of the high priest and what does this mean for Israel yet future?

m). Can you see the enormous significance of that which we see in Numbers Chapter 35?

5). Read Hebrews 5:5-6 – What do these verses tell us about Christ present and future?

a). What do these 2 verses tell us about the timeframe for Christ's Melchizedek Priesthood?

b). What do you know about Christ's High Priestly ministry at the present time?

c). Why is Christ able to minister for Christians at present but not for Jews?

d). When does Christ's present ministry end with respect to the church?

e). What event then will fulfill that pictured through the death of the high priest in Numbers Chapter 35?

f). In order for Israel to be able to take advantage of the ransom/atonement that is available for her what role must Christ have on Israel's behalf?

g). For Christ to operate on behalf of Israel in this way what must happen to the nation first?

h). Given that Christ is from the tribe of Judah what must happen before Christ can minister as Priest on Israel's behalf?

i). Where do we find reference to this in both the OT and the NT?

j). So, given the sequencing provided by the 7 feasts given to Israel when will this New Covenant have to be made?

k). Read Genesis 14:17-19 – What is pictured in these verses and how do they connect with that which we have been looking at?
