Study Questions

1). What pattern had we identified last week to which all judgment of the eternally saved conforms?

a). How had we seen this with regards to Christians and which scriptures did we look at?

b). Apart from the 10 virgins and the wedding guest what other examples of separation have we looked at over the years?

c). What ultimately is the purpose for this separation?

d). With all this in mind, what should we expect to see with regards to OT saints and Jews beyond the end of the Tribulation?

e). Read Revelation 20:4-5 – What do we see in these verses?

f). On what basis is this separation made?

g). What then should we expect to find with regards to the eternally saved Gentiles who are alive at the end of the Tribulation?

2). Read Matthew 25:31-46 – Which particular group of individuals do these verses deal with?

a). What timeframe is set for us in v31?

b). What do we see taking place in v32-33 and how does this correspond with the pattern we have already seen established?

c). Why can't the phrase 'all the nations' be inclusive of all Gentiles following Armageddon and what specifically are we told in v34 that makes this certain?

d). What metaphors are used to describe those separated at this time and where is each group placed?

e). Which are the verses that show us how faithfulness is described?

f). What in essence then is this group's faithfulness based on?

g). How does our own experience of past weeks help us to understand what is taking place with regards to how the Gentiles' treat the Jews?

h). Would it be possible for the 144000 to preach 'this message of the Kingdom' without stressing the importance of the Jews to the fulfillment of God's purpose?

i). Would this have been heard by those designated goats as well as the sheep?

j). Which verses lay out for us the 'goats' unfaithfulness?

k). With respect to our own experience how could taking or not taking the mark of the beast and the treatment of Jews form a secondary application?

l). According to v41 what is the outcome for the 'goats'?

m). How is this same thing described in v46?

n). What are all the other ways that we have seen this same outcome for the unfaithful eternally saved described and how should we understand them collectively?

o). What might we say about the role of the Tribulation martyrs and the Sheep within Christ's Kingdom?

3). With the completion of these final 2 judgments of the eternally saved what now is at an end and what is at its beginning?

a). What do we now know about God's 3 firstborn sons?

b). What will now be happening in the heavens and which scriptures did we look at?

c). What can we say about Israel on the earth?

d). Which scriptures in Genesis did we see would be fulfilled?

e). Read Jonah 3:1-3 – How will these verses be fulfilled?

f). Which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

g). Which scripture did we look at in connection with Israel's future prosperity?

h). Which feast will be fulfilled throughout this time?

i). What should we remember in order to temper our euphoria at these amazing events?

j). What do we know about the events surrounding Satan's release from the bottomless pit and what would these events witness to?

4). Read Revelation 2:7 – What is the overcomers' promise in this verse?

a). Where do we first see the tree of life?

b). What does this tree have to do with Adam and the Woman being eternal beings?

c). So, what is its purpose in the Garden of Eden?

d). When do Adam and the Woman no longer have access to the tree and what does God do to enforce His decision?

e). Where are the other references in scripture to the tree of life and do we see anything significant in these references?

f). What does the tree of life appear in Revelation Chapter 2 in connection with?

g). So, what is the purpose for the tree of life in the midst of the paradise of God?

5). Read Acts 3:20-21 – What are the key words highlighted in these verses and what do you think these key words mean?

b). Read 8:19-22 – What is the creation eagerly waiting for and when will this be?

c). According to v20 what happened to creation and when did this happen?

d). What does the end of v20 tell us about creation?

e). What is the promise in v21, when will this come to pass and what does it mean?

f). What does v22 tell us about creation in the present?
