Study Questions

1). Read Genesis 22:18 and Revelation 2:26-27 – What do these verses tell us about the Millennial Kingdom of Christ?

a). Read Genesis 1:26 – What connection does this verse have with the Millennial Kingdom?

b). ‘The times of the restoration of all things’ – to what does this phrase refer?

c). Read 1 Corinthians 15:24-26 – What do we find clearly stated in these verses?

d). What is the ultimate conclusion from the accomplishment of the things seen in these verses?

2). Read Revelation 20:1-3 – Time wise where do these verses take us to?

a). What do we learn from these verses?

b). Why is sin still possible even though Satan is bound for 1000 years and which scripture did we look at the explains this?

c). Read Zechariah 8:22-23 and Zechariah 14:16-17 – What do these sets of verses tell us about the Gentile nations during the Millennium?

d). Who would those seen in Chapter 14 be aligning themselves with and why would this be the case?

e). How would that seen in Chapter 14 be connected with what we read in James 1:14-15?

3). Read Revelation 20:7-9 – What do we see taking place in these verses and when do these events take place?

a). What specifically do we find that Satan will do at this time that he has been prevented from doing for the 1000 years?

b). How should we understand Gog and Magog?

c). If some of the Gentile nations have been in rebellion against Christ while Satan was bound how should we understand the nature of the deception that he brings to them upon his release?

d). Which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

e). What happens as a result of Satan deceiving the nations and what is the reason for this particular location being selected?

f). What parallel is there between the events that precede the Millennium and those that follow it with respect to Satan?

g). What is significant about the circumstances that precede and the circumstances that follow the Millennial Kingdom with regards to the attempted destruction of the Jews?

h). How then will the destruction of the rebellious Gentiles after the Kingdom Age be different from their destruction prior to the Kingdom Age?

i). What specifically happens to Satan and his angels at this point and who are waiting for them?

j). How does all of this bring to fulfillment that which we see in 1 Corinthians 15:24-26?

k). Once Christ has delivered up the Kingdom to God the Father, what must now happen before the endless ages begin, and why must this happen?

4). Read Revelation 20:11-15 – Who is sitting on the great white throne and how would we know?

a). What are we told about earth and heaven in v11?

b). What specifically is this verse referring to and where did we go in Peter to find this described?

c). What do we read in v11 from Peter and what does our answer need to be?

d). What are we told in v14 from Peter?

e). So then, between which 2 points in time does the great white throne judgment take place and what would this tell us about the location for this judgment?

f). So who will be present at this judgment and what physical condition will they be in?

g). What is not being judged and how would we know?

h). So, what is being judged and what are they to receive?

i). What must their works be judged in relation to and what would this tell us about the value of their works?

j). How are those who appear at this judgment described in Revelation 20:12? What does this mean?

k). Read Revelation 20:13 again – what can we say about the terminology used in this verse?

l). What would this now mean for ‘Death’ and ‘Hades’ and what subsequently happens to them?

m). What happens to all those who had previously resided in the ‘sea’, ‘Death’ and ‘Hades’?

n). Were they ever supposed to be there and how would we know?

o). What does this now mean for all that throughout Man’s history, has been in opposition to God?

p). What is now left?

q). What parallels are there between the coming of the Millennial Kingdom and the coming of the eternal ages?

5). Read Revelation 21:1-5 – What do we see happening in v1-3 and how should we understand there being ‘no more sea’?
