Study Questions

1). Read Revelation 21:1-5 – What have we learned about the tree of life?

a). What do we see in v3?

b). What about v4?

c). Read v5 again – Where did we see a parallel verse to this?

d). How should we understand that which is presented in both these verses?

e). How is 'night' presented in the scriptures and which verses did we look at in connection with this?

f). What is the only way in which Christians can navigate their way through the time associated with 'night'?

g). So, how should we understand there being 'no night' during the endless ages?

h). What is said at the very end of Revelation 22:5 and what does this tell us?

2). Read Revelation 1:1, 22:6-7 and 22:12 – What are the significant things that we learn from these verses?

a). What verses did we look at in Matthew and Luke that tell us what to do as we await Christ's return?

b). How intentional should we be in doing these things and what if we're not?

c). What are we told at the end of Revelation 22:7? How does this connect with that which we have just been studying? And what would this mean in practice?

d). Which scriptures did we look at that present a related thought to that which we see in 22:7 and what do we learn from them?

e). What remains the focus for everything we see in the Book of Revelation and which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

3). Read Revelation 22:14-16 – What contrast is presented in v14-15?

a). Where have we seen that presented in these verses elsewhere in the Book of Revelation?

b). What do we know about the words used to describe those who will be denied access to the city?

c). Read Revelation 22:18 – what do we see in this verse and what is the only way that we can be sure of avoiding the things written in it?

4). Read Luke 21:33-36 – What is significant about v33?

a). What are the first words in v34 and what do they say to us?

b). Why do we need to do this and which scripture did we look at?

c). How should we understand the phrase, 'counted worthy'?

d). What 'things' would this enable us to escape from? And how should we best understand what these 'things' picture for us?

e). What would it look like for a Christian to be engaged in these 'things'?

f). Read Luke 17:32 – What does this verse teach us about this same situation?

g). Read Luke 21:36 again- According to this verse what do we need to do to have victory over the things of this world?

h). Which 2 prayers did we look at in connection with this?

i). In essence what do these prayers ask for?

j). What further commentary do we find in Ephesians 6:18?

k). What is the context for this verse in Ephesians Chapter 6 and what should we learn from this?

l). If we do all of this correctly what does Luke 21:36 tell us will be the result?

m). What impact, if any, has our study of 'From Here To Eternity' had upon your race of the faith?

n). Is there any one thing that you have found to be particularly noteworthy from these 26 teachings?
