Study Questions

1). What is Satan's primary mode of operation?

a). Where do we first see this in action in foundation and what is significant about this first mention?

b). What has happened within the 'Church' as a result of Satan's deception and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

c). Where would we go in the scriptures to get a succinct overview of this entire process?

d). Read John 8:44 – How should we understand Satan being a 'murderer' within the context of the 'Church'?

e). Read 2 Corinthians 2:11b – does our lack of ignorance give us immunity to the devil's devices and if not why not?

f). What is the only way in which we can be assured of protection from Satan's wiles? And what does this look like in practice?

g). What realization are we again drawn to in this and which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

2). In what way have we seen Satan's deceitfulness within the Book of the Revelation?

a). What is the purpose for this deception as we see it in this Book and which scripture did we look at that prophecies about it?

b). What does 2 Corinthians 11:14 have to say and how does this relate to Revelation 6:2?

c). What counterfeit comes out of Revelation 6:2 that we find prophesied in Ezekiel 37:26?

d). What other things would we want to note from this verse in Ezekiel?

e). Which scripture does Israel's acceptance of Antichrist fulfill?

f). Read Revelation 13:13 – what counterfeit is taking place here and what is the dreadful irony that we would see in this?

g). What else might we conclude about the false prophet and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

3). Read Revelation 13:1-5 – what do we learn from the first 2 verses?

a). Where would we need to place Antichrist's death and resurrection within the chronology of the Tribulation and why would that be so?

b). Read Revelation 13:6-7 – Where in the chronology of the Tribulation are we now?

c). Which scriptures did we look at that deal with this same period of time and what do we learn from them?

d). Where do we need to place the death of the 2 witnesses in all this?

e). What has Antichrist accomplished at this time?

4). Read Revelation 12:1-6 – what do these 6 verses give to us?

a). What then happens in the verses, Revelation 12:7-17, that follow?

b). Read v5-6 and 13-14 again – what is the same and what is different in these 2 verses?

c). What does that described in v14 remind us of and why might this comparison be significant?

d). Read v11 and v17 again which group of people are being referenced here and how would we know?

e). What is said about them in Revelation 14:4-5 and how is this consistent with that which we see from the verses in the previous question?

f). So then, within the chronology of the Tribulation, where does the catching away of the 144000 take place?

g). By way of review, let's recap the events we have looked that take us from immediately before to immediately after the mid-point in the Tribulation?

5). Why are the 144000 taken to God and His throne and why is this now a place of safety for them?

a). Where have we seen this foreshadowed following the birth of another Male Child?

b). How does Herod provide a type of the Antichrist and which scripture did we look at?

c). Read Matthew 2:13 – What happens following the Lord being kept in a place of safety?

d). How does this foreshadow what will happen with the 144000?

6). Read Matthew 24:21 – what description is given to the events that follow the mid-point in the Tribulation?

a). Which verses from Revelation lead us into this same period of time?

b). What is said in Isaiah 63:4 and Luke 21:22 about this same period of time?

7). Any final thoughts?
