Study Questions

1). By way of review – What did we note last week about the experience of judgment for all Christians at the Judgment Seat and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

a). What did we note about the events that we saw recorded in Revelation Chapter 4?

2). In order for the final phase of the Lord's plans and purposes for the ages to be completed what must take place following the celebrations in Revelation Chapter 4?

a). Read Psalm 2:6-8 – What do these verses tell us about the inheritance that is to be redeemed?

b). Which scripture did we look at with regards to the material creation and which concerning those who will dwell on it?

c). What is so significant about the change of rulership that is to take place?

d). What difference did we note in this change of rulership between angels and fully redeemed Man?

e). What do we know of Satan's plan and actions within this context and what can we know from the Book of Esther about this?

3). Read Ruth 4:6-8 and Revelation 5:1-7 – How should we understand the parallel that exists in these verses between the close relative and God the Father?

a). Which scripture did we look at in connection with the Father's inheritance?

4). What does the resurrection/rapture of the 'Church' mark the end of?

a). What do we know about how God deals with His household servants?

b). From this what do we know with regards to Israel following the catching away of the 'Church'?

c). How have we seen this presented in Daniel Chapter 9?

d). What then can we conclude about the redemption of the inheritance and the Tribulation?

e). How do we see this prophetically in Matthew 13:44?

5). In Daniel 9:26 we read about 'the prince who is to come' – How can we identify this 'prince' through the study of the Book of Daniel?

a). Read 2 Thessalonians 2:6-8 – What is said about this 'prince' in these verses?

b). How should we understand him being 'revealed in his own time'?

c). What part if any do Christians play in this timeframe?

d). How does this fit with the sequence of events that we see in Revelation?

6). Read Daniel 8:8-9 and 21-25 – What additional information do we find in these verses about ‘the prince who is to come’?

a). What else do we see in Daniel 11:21 and 23 about him?

b). How does all of this fit with his description as a rider on a white horse in Revelation Chapter 6?

c). What does he appear in counterfeit form as?

d). What does he do that is reserved for Christ and the Millennial Kingdom?
