Study Questions

1). Read Revelation 6:1-2 – What do we know about the timeframe for Antichrist's appearance?

a). What symbolism do we see in the white horse?

b). What do we find in Daniel 11:21 about this?

c). What further symbolism do we see in Revelation 6:1-2 and what does this teach us?

d). Where do we find this pictured for us in foundation?

e). What connection is there here with Nimrod?

f). What is significant about the covenant that Antichrist makes with many in Israel?

g). What is the connection here with that which we read in John 19:15?

2). Read Daniel 9:27 – What does the phrase ‘with many’ tell us and how is this consistent with that which we see in Israel’s history?

a). What in history has God always done before bringing calamity on the unrepentant nation and which scripture did we look at for commentary on this?

b). What promise do we find in the last Book of the OT with regards to what God will do when He again deals with unrepentant Israel?

c). Which scripture did we look at in Revelation that introduces these prophets?

d). What does Revelation 11:4 make reference to and what do the verses in the reference say?

e). What does the imagery in Zechariah 4:14 immediately call to mind and which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

3). Within the OT who were the only 2 individuals who were empowered to perform supernatural signs?

a). What does 1 Corinthians 1:22a have to say about signs?

b). With respect to Moses what did the manifestation of supernatural signs have to do with?

c). What first mention principle is established here?

d). Does this hold true for what we know of Elijah?

e). Read Exodus 7:20, 1 Kings 17:1 and James 5:17 and compare these with Revelation 11:6 – What is the only conclusion to be drawn from this?

4). How would that seen with respect to Israel in the first half of the Tribulation parallel that seen at Christ's first advent?

a). Read Exodus 7:10-11 – What do we see happening in these verses and how will this be replicated in the days of Antichrist? Which scriptures did we look at?

b). What is the purpose for this?

5). Historically in Israel there has always been a remnant which has not succumbed to the evil embraced by the nation as a whole - where do we see this with regards to the first half of the Tribulation and which scriptures did we look at that describe it?

a). What should we note about the language used in these verses?

b). What is the timeframe given to the ministry of the 2 witnesses?

c). What is Antichrist doing during this time and how would we know?

d). What are the 2 reasons by which we would know that there are events taking place in the heavens as well as on the earth during this time?

6). Read Daniel 7:1-8 – What is being described in these verses?

a). How should we understand the ‘four winds of heaven stirring up the Great Sea’?

b). How is the 4<sup>th</sup> beast described?

7). Read Revelation 13:1-7 – What parallels do you see in these verses with Daniel Chapter 7?

a). What is significant about the way the beast coming out of the sea is described?
