Part Fourteen  
Study Questions

1). Heb 8:5 *as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. For He said, "See that you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."*

a). What does this tell us about the Tabernacle in the wilderness?

b). What does the construction of the Tabernacle in the wilderness look forward to?

c). What scripture do we have that talks about this?

2). Read 1 Corinthians 15:24-25 – what does this scripture tell us about the coming of the Day when God will Tabernacle with men?

a). What is laid out in foundation with regards to the coming of the Millennial Kingdom that we are waiting to be fulfilled?

b). What scriptures do we have from Genesis and Revelation that talk about this?

3). Heb 6:20 *where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek. 7:1 ¶ For this*

*Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God.....*What does this scripture tell us about Christ's role during the Millennium?

4). Christ is a present our great High Priest and during the Millennium He will be a 'High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek' – on what basis is He a High Priest now?

a). Why does the Priesthood have to change?

5). *Re 1:5 and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father,*

a). What do we learn here about the role of the many sons who will be brought to glory, during the Millennium?

b). Where does the word 'priest' inevitably take us?

c). What do you notice about the order that is presented at the end of v5 and the beginning of v6?

d). What is this teaching us?

e). What did Jesus teach the disciples on the night of the last supper concerning this?

f). What example is Jesus drawing from in presenting this and where do we find it in the scriptures?

g). Where does the washing of the priests hands and feet take place?

h). Where is the Bronze Laver located?

i). What is the warning that is given concerning a failure of the priest to wash the hands and feet?

j). What does 1 John 1:6-9 have to say about this?

k). What does Ephesians 5:25-27 have to say about this?

6). If we go to our picture of the Tabernacle and lay the cross over it what can we see with regards to each of the elements?

a). Read Luke 9:23 – What connection can you make between this and the picture of the cross on the Tabernacle?

b). Can you connect this with Ephesians 4:15?

c). As we begin our journey through the Tabernacle to the Holy of Holies, where must our journey begin?

d). What would take place at the Brazen Altar in the Tabernacle in the wilderness?

e). Using this as a picture for our own experience can you make a connection between Romans 12:1 and Hebrews 4:12-13?

f). Having allowed the Word to bring death to the man of flesh what must happen next in our journey through the Tabernacle?

g). All of this is a present process with a future fulfillment – what would the future fulfillment be?

h). Do you remember what would happen to the priest who entered the Holy Place without washing?

7). Let's now move to the resurrection/rapture of the church - *Re 1:12 Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands,* - Using the imagery of the Tabernacle, where is John and where are the 7 churches?

a). What then would be the outcome for those Christians who have not allowed the Word of God to cleanse them?

b). What scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

c). What will be the outcome for those who have allowed the Word of God to cleanse them?
