a). What is Abraham's response in Genesis 22:8?

c). Within the context of these verses what lamb had God provided?

d). Is there any significance to the last sentence in v8?

e). Within a typological framework, what is contained in Abraham's response to Isaac's question?

f). Where did we see the answer to Isaac's question and what else is stated in this verse?

3). Read Genesis 22:9 – What does this verse teach us?

a). What conclusion would we draw with regards to Isaac actions?

b). What does this verse show us about the antitype?

c). What commentary does scripture give on Christ's actions?

4). Read Genesis 22:10-13 – What does the Angel of the Lord do?

a). What is caught in a thicket and what is this a picture of?

b). What happens to this ram and why is it significant?

c). What does this teach us about the antitype?

d). What opportunity does this provide for every person for the last 2000 years

e). What must ant person do to take advantage of this opportunity?

5). Read Galatians 3:8 – What does this verse tell us?

a). What do you think this would mean that Abraham knew?

b). What would the 'gospel' consist of and what scripture did we look at in connection with this?

c). What must resurrection always have to do with?

d). Read Hebrews 11:17 again – what is significant about the phrase 'offered up Isaac'?

6). Read Genesis 22:19 – who is missing from this account?

a). Why is Isaac's return not recorded?

b). When in the scriptural record do we see Isaac again and what is he doing?

c). What has happened in the 2 Chapters that precede this event and what is to happen in the Chapter that comes after it?

d). What do the events in these chapters picture for us and how does this work out in the antitype?

e). Do you have any thoughts on all this?

7). So again, what is pictured in Genesis Chapter 23 and how do we see this presented in the scriptures?

8). Read Genesis Chapter 24:1-6 – What is happening in these verses?

a). What specific instructions is the oldest servant given and who is he a picture of?

b). What does the oldest servant take with him and what is the purpose for him taking these things?

c). What scriptures did we look at to see how this plays out in the antitype and what does this mean for Christians today?

d). What choice does each Christian who is shown these things have to make and where have we seen this same decision pictured in another book?

9). Read Genesis 24:13-15 – Where is the prospective bride to be found and what would this mean for us in the antitype?

a). What do you think would be the most crucial element involved in drawing water from the well and why would this be so?

b). What would be the consequence for those who don't draw water after this fashion?

c). Read Genesis 24:61-67 – What is pictured in these verses and where do we see this same event in the antitype?

d). What do you think about the way this event is presented in the Genesis account?
