Study Questions

1). Heb 11:29 *By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned. 30 By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days. 31 By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.* What do these 3 verses all have to do with?

- a). What do we learn from the type of the Red Sea incident?
- b). What do we learn from the type of Jericho?
- c). So putting these together, what do they teach us about the destruction of Gentile world power at the end of the Tribulation?

2). How does the kingdom of Antichrist begin and how would we know?

- a). What in fact is this peaceable perception and how would we know?
- b). What does Daniel 9:27 record happens in the middle of the week?
- c). What commentary does 2 Thessalonians give on this event?
- d). What did Daniel have to say about it in Chapter 8?
- e). How is this same thing presented in Revelation Chapter 6?

f). What does the Lord have to say about this in Luke Chapter 21?

3). Antichrist's true intent has already been prophetically revealed in the scriptures. Where do we find reference to this in the Psalms?

a). What is Antichrist's central aim that we see here?

b). Where have we seen a type for this in a previous Book we have studied?

c). Now, with regards to the treatment of God's people what Had God told Abraham in Genesis 15:14?

d). How does God further develop this in that which He tells Moses in Exodus 17:14?

e). How is this same thing described in Daniel 2:35?

f). All in all then what do we learn from this?

4). Read Revelation 6:1-8 – What panoramic picture is given to us in these verses?

a). What does that pictured here provide a foundational framework for?

b). How does the black horse and its rider give us commentary on what happens with the fiery, red horse and its rider?

c). What further commentary does the pale horse and its rider give us on what happens with the fiery, red horse and the black horse?

d). What period of time then is covered by the breaking of the first 4 seals on the 7 sealed scroll?

e). What does the breaking of the 5th and 6th seal provide for us with regards to the breaking of the first 4 seals?

f). Read Revelation 6:9-11 – What is presented in these verses?

g). Read Revelation 6:12-17 – What is presented in these verses?

h). Does the breaking of the 7th seal with the trumpet and bowl/vial judgments introduce a new set of judgments or more detail on what we have already seen?

i). How is God's Divinely complete judgment shown to us through the seals, trumpets and bowls/vials?

5). What condition was the kingdom of Pharaoh in Egypt in after the 10 plagues?

a). Despite this what do we read in Exodus 14:5-7?

b). What does this teach us?

c). What condition will the kingdom of Antichrist be in at the conclusion of God's judgment?

- d). What will he do despite this?
- e). Where have we seen this described earlier?
- f). How is this described in Revelation 19:19?
- g). What has God already had to say about this?
- h). What did Isaiah prophecy about this?
- i). Where did we see the fulfillment of this prophecy?
- j). What did the prophet Joel have to say about this?
- k). Where do we find the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy?
- l). Read Revelation 19:20-21 – What do these verses give us?
- m). What will take place following this?
- n). What scripture is now fulfilled?
