Study Questions

1). Heb.12:26 *whose voice then shook the earth;*

a). When God shakes the earth at Mt. Sinai and speaks with an audible voice what had He already made abundantly clear to the principalities and powers?

b). Read John 5:46-47 – What do these verses tell us about Israel’s heart and mind throughout their generations?

c). Because of Israel’s refusal to hear what does God do to the nation?

d). What does God take from the temple?

e). What does He bring to an end?

f). What is ‘the times of the Gentiles’? When did it begin? And when will it end?

g). Read Daniel 2:32-35 – what do these verses tell us about the times of the Gentiles?

h). Read Daniel 9:24-27 – What do these verses tell us about the times of the Gentiles?

- i). What does the Lord have to say about this in Luke Chapter 21?
- 2). Why does God speak through Haggai concerning a future shaking of the earth and also heaven once a remnant of the nation has returned from exile?
- a). What might we say about God's purpose for Israel and Man?
  - b). Which scripture did we look at in connection with this?
- 3). What do we see progressively deteriorating as pictured through the opening of the first 4 seals on the 7 sealed scroll?
- 4). *Re 6:12 I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake [shaking];* - What do we see God doing here that He has done before?
- a). What takes place 'in the heavens' as a result of this shaking?
  - b). What takes place 'on the earth' as a result of this shaking?
  - c). What does Haggai 2:22 tell us about this?
  - d). What further commentary do we find in Isaiah 24:19-23?
  - e). How are we to understand what is pictured through the imagery of the sun, moon and stars?

f). Read Genesis 15:2-20 – What do you see in this account if we view it as a type?

5). *the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood.*

a). What are we to learn from the description of the sun and the moon here?

b). How does the imagery of the stars add into this?

c). *every mountain and island was moved out of its place.* – How should we understand ‘every mountain and island’?

d). Which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

e). So what exactly are we looking at in relation to ‘every mountain and island’?

6). Read Revelation 6:15-17 – who is pictured in these verses?

a). What are they trying to hide from?

b). How are we to understand ‘the caves and rocks of the mountains’?

c). Why is there no help and security for them?

d). Which 2 scriptures did we look at that describe the circumstances that we see here?

- e). What in particular does the Lord have to say about these circumstances?
- 7). Read Hebrews 12:27-29 – What is it that is to be removed by the shaking?
- a). What remains that cannot be shaken?
  - b). What does all of this mean with regards to the governance of the earth?
  - c). How does Micah describe this?
  - d). What is said about this in Isaiah 9:7 and what can we conclude from this?
  - c). Which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?
  - d). What are we admonished to do because we are receiving this Kingdom that cannot be shaken?
  - e). What do you think this looks like in practice?
  - f). What are we reminded of if we should not do this?
  - g). Read Exodus 24:16-17 – exactly what do you see from these verses?
