 - a). How does this verse relate to Malachi 4:1-3?
 - b). Read Malachi 3:2-4 – what do these verses make clear with regards to the fulfillment of God’s promise to Israel?
 - c). Which other verse did we look at that showed us the same thing?
 - d). When will the judgment that brings Israel to repentance take place?
 - e). How did we see this presented in Revelation Chapter 6?

- 2). By way of review – What does the opening of the first 4 seals give to us?
 - a). What do we learn from the opening of the 5th seal?
 - b). What do we learn from the opening of the 6th seal?

- 3). Which 2 scriptures did we read that provide for us the foundation upon which the OT types can be built?
 - a). What do we learn from the verse in Genesis Chapter 3?

- b). What do we learn from the verses in Genesis Chapter 4?
 - c). Read Genesis 5:21-24 and Genesis 5:28-30 – What can we know from a generational standpoint about the 2 individuals in these verses and why is this significant?
 - d). What do we learn from Enoch in the type?
 - e). What do we learn from Noah in the type?
 - f). Read Genesis 6:11-13 – How do these verses look prophetically to the future?
- 4). Read Genesis 8:10-12 – Which individual is introduced in these verses and who does he picture?
- a). What is said in v9 about him and how does this connect with Revelation Chapter 6?
 - b). What geographical connections are established in these verses, how do we see them played out through the course of Jewish history and which scripture did we look at?
 - c). Read Genesis 11:1-9 – What do we learn here concerning Antichrist's future kingdom?
 - d). What does God do and how does this connect with the flood of Noah?

e). Which scripture did we look at for commentary?

5). Who is introduced at the end of Genesis Chapter 11?

a). How does he provide a panoramic type for the experience of Israel yet future?

b). In which 2 places in the account of Abraham's life do we find additional detail on the overthrow of Gentile world power?

c). Which scripture did we look at for commentary?

d). How do we see this same thing pictured in the account of Joseph's life?

6). Give a brief summary of all we have looked at so far.

7). Read Exodus 1:8-14 – What type do we find at the beginning of the Book of Exodus?

a). How does the Book of Exodus continue from this point?

b). Where in this account do we find another picture for the overthrow of Gentile world power?

c). In history, what makes the destruction of the power of Egypt necessary and how does this apply to Antichrist's kingdom?

d). Which scriptures did we look at for commentary?
