Study Questions

1). Read Malachi 4:4-5 – What does the conjunction of Moses and Elijah together represent?

a). Which events did we look at where this representation would of necessity have to be in view?

b). How would you explain Moses and Elijah’s significance during the first 3 ½ years of the Tribulation?

c). What should the promise surrounding Moses and Elijah in the final verses of the OT cause Israel to conclude?

d). What poignancy would we see here with respect to the ministry of John the Baptist?

2). Read Malachi 4:4 again and John 5:46 – How are these 2 verses connected?

a). What must be in view in the statement ‘the Law of Moses with the statutes and the judgments’?

- b). With this in view, what did Moses record that establishes foundational truth?
- c). What did Moses record with regards to the consequences of Israel's actions?
- d). Which commands did Moses record that are pertinent to Israel's present condition?
- e). What did Moses record concerning the destruction of Gentile world power?
- f). Why then would you say that Israel is commanded to remember the Law of Moses with the statutes and the judgments?
- g). What do you think this might tell us about Elijah's ministry to Israel before the end of the Tribulation?
- 3). Read Ezekiel 20:34-38 – Who will be present in the 'wilderness of the peoples' and how will they have gotten there?
- a). Look at v37-38 again – what is the first thing mentioned here that will take place following the re-gathering?
- b). What would we know about those described as 'rebels' and which scriptures did we look at?

- c). Which prophecy is fulfilled at this judgment?
- d). Which scriptures did we look at concerning the faithful in Israel?
- e). What do we know about the judgment that takes place?
- f). What is the timely reminder for us in this and which scripture did we

look at?

4). Read Ezekiel 20:37 again – what is the second thing recorded here following the nation’s re-gathering and where is the foundational type?

a). What covenant do we find here and where was it prophesied in the OT and what does the scripture say?

b). What is recorded about this same covenant in the Gospels and what does the scripture say?

c). In both sets of scripture what is the New Covenant presented in conjunction with?

d). What can we conclude from this?

e). What connection is there between that pictured in the Day of Atonement and that which is recorded in Matthew 26:27-29?

f). What is recorded in Hebrews Chapter 8 concerning this covenant and what do you notice about these verses?

g). What do we see with respect to this New Covenant that is different to Sinai and the Old Covenant?

h). What was the purpose for the establishment of the Old Covenant?

i). What was built with respect to this end, what event marked the beginning of the Theocracy and which scripture did we look at?

j). What will be the purpose for the establishment of the New Covenant?

k). What will Christ build in the land in the Millennial Kingdom?

l). What will happen when this building is complete and what will it mean?

m). Which feast is starting to be fulfilled here?

n). Where is this event foreshadowed and what does the scripture say?

o). What is still to happen before we get to this point in time though?
