Study Questions

1). Read Malachi 4:1-3 – What issue is addressed in these verses?

a). Where else in the OT had we seen this same promise and which scriptures did we look at?

b). Read Isaiah 46:9-10 – what do we learn about God in these verses?

c). Which scripture did we look at for additional commentary on this?

d). What connection is there between the beginning of Isaiah 46:9 and Malachi 4:4?

e). Why would Israel need to ‘remember’?

f). What does remembrance of this sort require?

g). Does Israel have this at present?

h). What has God promised them with respect to this?

i). What then goes hand in hand with the promise of vindication and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

2). What events must transpire in order for Israel to be back in the land?

- a). Once Israel is in the land what does Antichrist do next?
- b). Where do we find the type for this and which scripture did we look at?
- c). What is at the heart of Antichrist's actions and which verses from the Psalms did we look at that give us commentary on this?
- d). Read Psalm 2:4-7 and Psalm 83:13-18 – What do we find in these verses?
- e). How is that seen in the great and dreadful day of the Lord different from that which has been seen in history and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?
- f). How does the image from Nebuchadnezzar's dream fit into this picture?
- g). How is the great and dreadful day of the Lord presented in Revelation 14 and Revelation 19?
- h). Read Hosea 8:7 – how can we relate this verse to the great and dreadful day of the Lord?
- 3). What happens to the eternally saved Gentiles who are alive on the earth following the great and dreadful day of the Lord?

a). Which scripture did we look at that describes this event?

b). What in particular do we note about the events described in these verses?

4). How should we characterize the Millennial Kingdom of Christ and which scriptures did we look at?

a). So, what is to be accomplished through the time of the Millennial Kingdom?

b). Read Revelation 20:7-10 – what is described in these verses and according to the scripture when does this take place?

c). What is the similarity between the end of Man's Day and the end of the Lord's Day?

d). What do you think would be the purpose for this event do you think?

e). What is the final conclusion?

f). How does this relate to that which we read earlier in 1 Corinthians Chapter 15?

g). What further commentary do we find in 1 Corinthians 15:27-28?

h). What presumably happens at this point and which scripture did we look at that describes it?

i). What must happen before the New Heavens and New Earth are brought into existence and which scripture did we look at in connection with this and what do we see taking place?

j). What is the significance of Death and Hades being cast into the lake of fire?

k). Once the events of the Great White Throne have taken place what happens next and where do we find this with respect to 'time'?

l). What does Peter have to say about this?

m). What detail is given on this in Revelation Chapter 21?

n). Do you have any thoughts on this?

5). Read Malachi 1:1-5 – what do we find in these verses?

6). Read 2 Peter 3:14 – what do we learn for ourselves here?

7). What for you has been most important from our study of Malachi?
