Study Questions

1). Given Israel's history of unbelief and disobedience why did the Lord have to come to them with the offer of the Kingdom of the Heavens and how do we know this from the scriptures?

a). What events in Matthew Chapter 12 specifically mark the religious leaders' rejection of the offer of the Kingdom of the Heavens and in what context does the Lord make the pronouncement about the Kingdom being taken from them?

b). How does all of this fit with what we looked at in Matthew Chapter 23 and the beginning of Chapter 24?

2). In order to set the correct timeframe for the events recorded in Matthew 24-25 we are going to lay out three panoramic sequences – for the first 2 of these panoramas show what is happening in the type and how this is fulfilled in the antitype -
