Study Questions

1). Read Daniel Chapter 9:1-3 – What has Daniel discovered, according to these verses, and what does he now expect to happen which causes him to pray as he does?

a). Read Daniel 9:22-27 – In what way does the angel Gabriel correct Daniel's thinking in these verses?

b). What is the time from which the 490 years are to be counted? What would this tell Daniel concerning his own lifetime and how do we know that these 490 years have not been completed yet? What does this mean from our perspective?

2). Read Matthew 24:4-22 – What does the Lord describe in these verses and what is the method by which He presents this picture?

a). How does this connect with what we have learned from Daniel Chapter 9?

b). What is significant from Israel's perspective about the final statement in Matthew 24:8?

3). How does the Lord set about answering the disciples' question about the timing of Israel's 'desolation' and the destruction of the temple and what is the answer that He gives them?

a). How does the Lord set about answering the disciples' question about the sign of Christ's coming and the end of the age and what is the answer that He gives them?

b). Which particular time period have we seen presented to us in the verses we have looked at in Matthew Chapter 24 and what do we know about this same time period from the panoramic sequences we looked at last week?

c). How important is that which we have studied from Daniel in understanding what the Lord tells His disciples?

4). What seems to you to be the most significant thing we need to learn from all this and why would you say so?
