Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 25:31-33 – Why are these verses introduced at this point in Chapter 25?

a). What do we learn from v31-46 concerning the Gentiles and what parallels can we see here with what we know concerning Christians?

b). Read Mathew Chapter 26:1-2 – what if anything is significant about that which the Lord says to the disciples in these verses?

2). Read Genesis 19:14-27 and then read Luke 17:32

a). What is the context in which we find the verse from Luke?

b). Putting this together with what we read in Genesis 19:14-27, what should we learn from all this with respect to ourselves, particularly as we come to the end of our study of Matthew 24-25?

c). Read Luke 9:59-62 – What do these verses add to that which we have just been studying?

d). Read Hebrews 11:13-15 and Hebrews 12:2 – What do these verses add to that which we have just been studying?

e). How do these verses from Genesis, Luke and Hebrews connect with the parables we have been studying?

3). Finally, what is the most significant thing that you personally will take away from this study of Matthew 24-25? [Everyone will need an answer]
