Study Questions

1). Read Ruth 2:15-17, John 19:32-34 and Philippians 2:12 – How might we connect all these verses together?

a). What connection does John 19:32-34 have with Genesis Chapter 2?

b). How does Ephesians 5:25-32 fit into this whole picture?

c). What is the most significant thing that you personally learn from looking at these scriptures?

2). Read Ephesians 4:11-16 – What do these verses have to do with what the Lord purposely leaves for us?

a). How does this apply to other relationships we might find ourselves in?

b). What do you learn personally from this?

c). Now add Acts 2:42 and 46 into this picture – what do we now learn concerning that which is purposely left for us?

d). How might this also be brought over into your own personal study time?

3). Read 1 Peter 1:3-9 – What do we learn from these verses and why must this testing take place?

a). What do we learn from James 1:2-4 about this same thing?

b). Read Luke 18:18-23 – in the light of what we are learning what do we see in this account of the rich young ruler?

4). What connection is there if any, between all we are learning in this study and what we know of keeping our old man in the place of death?

a). Read Revelation 19:8 – What are the ‘righteous acts of the saints’ and what are they producing?

b). Now add Matthew 7:7 into this and then read Matthew 6:33 – What do you now see in this verse?

c). Read 2 Corinthians 4:17 and James 2:23 - how do these verses connect with each other and with the rest of what we are learning?

5). How might all of this help clarify your face of the faith?
