Study Questions

1). Read Ruth 3:8-11 – What do we see taking place in verses 8-9?

a). Read v10 again – How do you think we should explain this verse with respect to the faithful Christian?

b). Again with regards to the faithful Christian, how should we explain all the people of Boaz's town knowing Ruth is a virtuous woman in v11?

2). How should we define Ruth's actions from her journey through to the request she makes on Boaz's threshing floor and how do we know this to be true?

a). How should we define Boaz's response to Ruth and why would this be so?

b). What encouragement is there in this for us and our future meeting with Christ?

3). How does Ruth Chapter 3:7-4:10 correspond to the Chapters in the Book of the Revelation?

a). Who are the 24 Elders seen in Revelation Chapter 4 and how would we know?

b). Read Ruth 3:12-18 – Who is introduced in v12 and what is significant about him with respect to the fulfillment of Ruth's request?

c). What does Boaz tell Ruth he will do and what is to happen to Ruth in the meantime?

4). Read Ruth 2:17 – Explain what is taught through these verses and which scripture in Corinthians did we equate with the ephah of barley?

a). Read Matthew 6:33 and James 2:22-23 and Philippians 3:9 – what do we learn from these verses?

b). Read Ruth 2:12 – what is Ruth promised in this verse and why would she receive this?

c). How is this same promise described in Hebrews?

d). Taking all this into consideration, why does Boaz give Ruth 6 ephahs of barley to carry away in her shawl?

e). What do we learn from this for ourselves and which scripture did we look at in connection with this?

f). Read Ruth 3:18 again – What does this look like in the antitype?

g). Where will the Bride be while Christ redeems the inheritance and which other types show this same thing?

5). Read Ruth 4:1-8 – what is taking place in these verses and where did we see this same thing in the Matthew 13 parables?
