Part Fifteen
Study Questions

1). Read Ruth 3:17-18 – What does it mean that Ruth does not return to her mother-in-law ‘empty handed’?

a). Bringing this over into the antitype, what impact will the events at the Judgment Seat for the faithful Christian have on Israel?

b). Read Ruth 3:12-13 – Taking this into the antitype what does it mean for the faithful Christian to ‘stay this night’ and ‘lie down until morning’?

c). Can you think of any other scriptures outside of Ruth that talk about what will happen ‘in the morning’?

2). Read Ruth 4:3-6 – How many from Elimelech’s family have the right to redeem and who are they?

a). Bringing this into the antitype how many have the right to redeem and who are they?

b). Why are they the only ones who can redeem?

c). Why can't God the Father redeem the inheritance?

d). What do we need to keep in mind about the designation 'wife' and 'firstborn son'?

e). Read the verses that show that seen in Ruth 4:7-8 in the Revelation. What similarities do you see?

f). Why is the Lord described in Revelation Chapter 5 as both 'the Lion of the tribe of Judah' and 'a lamb as though it had been slain'? And what do we learn from this?

g). Staying in the antitype what has the faithful Christian received that has brought us to the place where Christ is found worthy to open the scroll and what do we know about this inheritance? [Try to include all facets of the inheritance in this]

3). Read Ruth 4:8-10 – What happens in these verses with respect to Ruth and what do we learn from them about Christ’s Bride and where have we seen this before?

a). Write down the words that mark the redemption of the inheritance in Ruth and how does this compare with what we see in the Revelation?

b). How does the ‘death’ of Adam and the subsequent redemption of the inheritance fulfill that seen in Deuteronomy Chapter 25 and fulfill God’s stated purpose from the beginning?

c). Why did Adam have to be put out of the garden and Israel have to be put out of the land? And what about us?

d). What is the outcome of the redemption of the inheritance with regards to location for the Church and Israel during the Millennial Kingdom and which prophecy that we looked at will it fulfill?
