Study Questions

1). Read Galatians 4:4-6 – What connection is there between the Lord’s first advent and our adoption as firstborn sons?

2). Read Amos 3:7 – What is implicit in this verse with regards to the fullness of the time?

a). Is this true of the Lord’s first advent and where would we find evidence for this in the scriptures?

b). Does the Lord deal the same way with Man throughout His revelation to him?

c). What does this tell us about God and what would be His purpose in doing it?

3). How many significant events can we find with regards to Noah that would demonstrate God doing this very thing?

a). Where do we find the first of these and what does the scripture say?

- b). What should this have been declaring for those with eyes to see?
- c). Where did we find commentary on the building of the ark and what did we learn from that commentary?
- e). What do we know of Noah's lineage?
- f). What is the next significant event that we looked at?
- g). What commentary on this did we look at and what do we learn from it?
- h). Where do we find the final significant event?
- i). Putting all of these together then what can we say about those who inhabited the earth during the days of Noah before the flood?

4). Read Genesis 19:1 – what is the dual purpose for the angels going to Sodom?

- a). What impact did this have on the inhabitants of the town?
- b). What about those of Lot's household?
- c). What about Lot's immediate family?
- d). In respect of all this what can we say about the inhabitants of Sodom before the destruction of the city?

5). What other example did we find with respect to Joseph?

a). What about the Pharaoh of Moses' day?

b). What did we learn concerning Belshazzar and which scriptures did we look at?

c). What might we conclude from these examples?

d). What would be God's purpose in doing this?

6). Read Daniel 9:25-26 – What do we learn from this concerning the coming of Messiah?

a). Read Numbers 24:17 – what do we learn from this and what other related scripture did we look at?

b). How should we view the coming of the wise men within this context?

c). What happened subsequent to this and which scripture did we look at?

d). Read Genesis 49: 1 + 10, Genesis 9:6 and John 18:31 – What do we learn from putting all these together?

e). What impact did all these things have on the nation as a whole?

f). Which scripture did we look at concerning the outcome of Israel's actions at the Lord's first advent?

- g). What would we say then about God's dealings with the Jewish people?
- h). Which 2 scriptures did we look at with regards to God's encouragement and warning with respect to ourselves?
- i). What has God done with respect to making His plans and purposes known to us? And which scripture did we look at?
- j). What might we conclude from this?
- k). Read Luke 17:26-30 – What do these verses teach us and how do they apply to the day in which we live?
- l). Is there anything else we can know about the days in which we live and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?
- m). What should all of this make plain to us?
- n). Read 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 – What is the next event on God's prophetic timetable?
- o). What has He told us about this, why has He done so and which scriptures did we look at?
- p). So, where are you in the midst of this?
