Study Questions

- 1). Read Hebrews 2:5 – What does this verse clearly state for us?
  - a). What is the context in which we are to place Hebrews Chapter 11?
  
- 2). Read Hebrews 10:38-39 – exactly what are we told in these verses?
  - a). What do we know about the word ‘faith’ in v38 and the word ‘believe’ in v39?
  - b). So then, how should we understand what is meant by ‘the faith’?
  - c). Read 1 Corinthians 2:14 – What does this verse teach us about those who have access to faith to the saving of the soul?
  - d). Where do we find further commentary on this in Romans Chapter 1?
  - e). What does it mean for the just to live by faith?
  
- 3). Read Hebrews 11:1 – What 2 things are said about ‘the faith’ in this verse?
  - a). What does the word translated ‘substance’ mean and what does this tell us about having faith to the saving of the soul?

b). What is faith to the saving of the soul the 'substance' of and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

c). What does the word translated 'evidence' mean and what does this tell us about having faith to the saving of the soul?

d). Which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

e). Read Hebrews 11:2 – Given that which we have just studied, what does this tell us about 'the elders'?

f). What lesson is there here for us?

4). Read Hebrews 11:3 – What does this verse teach us about the outcome of having faith to the saving of the soul?

a). How should we understand the 'worlds' [lit. ages] being framed by the Word of God?

5). Read Hebrews 11:4-10 – What connection is there between the 4 OT saints in these verses and what we learned from Hebrews 11:1-2?

a). What does Hebrews 11:4-10 provide for us with regards to Israel?

b). What do these same verses provide for us with regards to the 'Church'?

c). Where was the focus for these OT saints and which verse concerning Abraham gives this to us?

6). Read Hebrews 11:6 again – What does this verse teach us? What would it mean from our perspective that ‘He [God] is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him?

a). What does this verse teach us about Abel, Enoch, Noah and Abraham?

b). Which verse tells us of the reward to be given to Abraham?

c). Has that which we see in these verses been completed for Abraham yet?

d). What would that tell you about the reward?

e). Which 2 scriptures did we look at with regards to diligently seeking Him?

f). What would it look like for us to be diligently seeking God?

g). Do you believe that God will reward you if you diligently seek Him?

h). What makes you believe that?

i). What might get in your way to make seeking God difficult?

j). How do you think you are doing with this at present?
