- 2). Read Daniel 9:24-27 – What do we see in these verses about God’s dealings with Israel?
  - a). What is the promise given in v14?
  - b). How does this connect with that which God had said to Cain?
  - c). How should we understand the phrase ‘70 weeks’?
  - d). How many years are we talking about and what is prophesied for the conclusion of this time?
  - e). What has God said in foundation concerning time and what does He tell us through Peter about it?
  - f). What does this mean for time as we know it at the present?
  - g). Read 2 Peter 3:1-7 – What do we learn in these verses concerning a large number of Christians?
  - h). How might that which Peter says in v1-2 apply to our study?

- i). What significant event happens 'after the sixty two weeks'?
  - j). What do we see next on this prophetic timetable?
  - k). What has to happen before this event though and why is it missing from Daniel's prophecy?
  - l). Through which one of the OT saints from Hebrews 11 is the resurrection/rapture of the 'Church' pictured?
  - m). To begin adding more detail to this where in foundation would we need to go and which scripture did we look at?
  - n). Which Chapters of Genesis also give us a foundational panoramic picture?
  - o). What do we see pictured in each of the chapters from Chapter 21 - 25?
- 3). Read Genesis 24:58 – what is significant about this verse from our perspective?
- a). Read Genesis 24:61-67 – What do we see pictured in these verses and what is important to note in them?
  - b). Who does Rebekah typify?
  - c). Which other OT character also typifies this same group of people?

d). Read Ruth 1:1-5 – What do we see in these verses and how do they relate to us?

e). Read Ruth 1:13-17 – What choice is faced by Ruth and Orpah here?

f). What would we know about Orpah here?

g). Read Ruth 3:1-3 – What do we see in these verses and what do they mean for us?

h). Why does Ruth do the things detailed here and why should we do the things pictured through them?

i). What does Boaz do after he has identified Ruth on his threshing floor and which scripture did we look at?

4). Read 2 Corinthians 5:10 – What additional information is given to us in this verse?

a). Where do we find additional commentary on this?

b). Read Revelation 1:10-20 – What information is given to us in these verses and what parallels do we find with 2 Corinthians and 1 Thessalonians?

c). Read Revelation 2:2-4 – What is taking place in these verses?

d). Along with Judgment what do we also find with regards to faithful Christians in Revelation Chapters 2-3?

e). Read Revelation 4:1-3 – What do we learn from these verses?

f). Read Revelation 5:1-7 – What do we see taking place in these verses?

g). How is this the same picture that we saw through Ruth?

h). How does this confirm that which we see pictured through Abel,

Enoch and Noah?
