Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 13:44 – How does this verse connect with Daniel Chapter 9 and which other scripture did we look at to go with this?

a). Why are there no details given to us concerning the purchase of the field in v44?

b). What outcome is common throughout the scriptures when it comes to that pictured through the purchase of the field and which scriptures did we look at?

2). Read Ephesians 1:13-14 – who are those seen in these verses?

a). What do these verses teach us about them?

b). What is the connection between these verses in Ephesians and Matthew 13:44?

3). Read Matthew 13:45-46 – what things does this parable have in common with the parable of the treasure and what is different?

a). What do we learn about the prophetic order of events from the panoramic sequence seen in Hebrews 11:1-8?

b). Read Revelation 19:1-9 – Where would we place these verses in the panoramic sequence from Hebrews?

c). What is happening in v7-9 and what is about to happen next?

4). Read Matthew 22:1-14 – Explain in as much detail as you can what is happening in this parable – what’s the connection with Revelation 19:7-9?

5). Read Ruth 3:1-9 – How do these verses connect with Revelation 19:7-9?

a). What is the connection between these verses from Ruth and the parable of the sower, the parable of the dragnet and the parable of the wedding feast?

b). From within the Book of Ruth who would be equivalent to those classified as 'bad' in the parable of the wedding feast?

c). What will take place after this encounter between Ruth and Boaz on Boaz's threshing floor?

d). Read Ruth 4:9-11 – Exactly what happens in v9-10?

e). Re-read Matthew 13:46 – who then is the pearl of great price?
